### **Notes from Fr. Tom**

Dear Loyola Parishioners & Visitors,

Last week we had Pentecost. This week we have Trinity Sunday. Next week we have the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Together, they summarize the whole of the Church: strangers formed into a community by the action of the Holy Spirit; held together by the love of God shared with us that is the essence of the love of God that holds the community of God together; sent out to do what they can do themselves and don't need God to do except to bless their work. The body of Christ is the Church formed by the action of the Spirit, held together by the love of God, serving humanity so that it may come to know God.

St. Paul reminds us the Church is a collection of sinful people formed by the Holy Spirit. And, it is messy. All these Spirit-filled people going off in different directions to carry out their perceived mission. So, forgiveness and mercy are absolute requirements of community life. Jesus revealed that before him.

So, there we have it, my thoughts for today.

#### 'CARE FOR OUR COMMON HOME' MAGIS TEAM

##### Let Us Be Merciful to Our Common Home, the Earth

From Pope Francis' Encyclical Laudato Si/On Care For Our Common Home: *In calling to mind the figure of Saint Francis of Assisi, we come to realize that a healthy relationship with creation is one dimension of overall personal conversion..... The Australian bishops spoke of the importance of such conversion for achieving reconciliation with creation: 'To achieve such reconciliation, we must examine our lives and acknowledge the ways in which we have harmed God's creation through our actions and our failure to act. We need to experience a conversion, or change of heart.'* "

Care For Our Common Home Magis Team Recycling Tip:

Boxes, Cartons and Cardboard

- Flatten or cut into pieces to no larger than 2 feet by 2 feet
- Remove plastic bags, plastic film or wax paper bags

Acceptable items include:

- Boxes for cereal, tissues, beverages, food, soap, etc.
- Gift, shirt and shoe boxes
- Hanging file folders
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper towel and toilet paper tubes
- Frozen food boxes (but not the ones that have a waxy, white coating on the inside)
- NO foil coated paperboard
- NO paper cups
