### OUR NEW ASSOCIATE PASTOR: FR. ROY JOSEPH, SJ

Dear Loyola Parishioners & Visitors,

Happy St. Ignatius of Loyola Feast Day! As always, we will be having our annual parish picnic in City Park following the 10:00 AM Sunday Mass, and simple receptions after each of our other Masses. Once again, it affords us an opportunity to welcome a new associate pastor, Fr. Roy Joseph to St. Ignatius of Loyola Church. He has been assigned to us full-time as he continues to discern where God is calling him in his Jesuit life.

Some of you have already met him—he concelebrated Masses last week during the week and on the weekend. Some of you have already read the following brief biography of him that appeared in *Jesuits* magazine, Summer 2016. But I suspect a great many have not, so today is a day to afford you an opportunity to do both—meet him and read about him.

**Roy M. Joseph, SJ**, 40, is the son of immigrants from India, members of the Syro-Malabar Catholic Church. A native of Atlanta, he attended Emory University, then earned a medical degree at the University of Szeged in Hungary, where he met the Jesuits. He entered the Society of Jesus in 2005. He has worked as a prison and hospital chaplain, worked with the poor in Tijuana, Mexico, and lived in a L'Arche community. He earned a master's degree in applied philosophy and health care ethics from Loyola University Chicago, then taught science for three years at Strake Jesuit College Preparatory in Houston. He earned a Masters of Divinity degree from the Boston College School of Theology and Ministry and served as deacon at St. Thomas Syro-Malabar Catholic Church. He will be a bi-ritual priest in the Latin and Syro-Malabar traditions.

I am grateful for Fr. Joseph's arrival and look forward to his time with us. His assignment here is significant. With 14 plus parishes to staff and only 5 newly ordained priests, the Provincial and his assistants had multiple parishes from which to choose in addition to retreat houses, universities, high schools, and new apostolic endeavors. They choose carefully. They chose Loyola. That says a lot about you and the importance of Loyola parish to the future of parish ministry in the Province.
