### **Notes from Fr. Tom**

Dear Loyola Parishioners & Visitors:

This weekend, our focus is Communion as we welcome some of our youth to share table fellowship with us for the first time. While we may read articles or hear news stories about some horrific thing a 7 or 8 year-old did, while we may read or hear stories of the exposure of children this age to pornography or peer-on-peer unwelcomed sexual behavior, listening to children's confessions reveals children who want to love their parents, siblings, teachers, peers, etcetera better but their desires to have their desires met leads them to do or say hurtful things at times. What can you say? That they will outgrow it? Not hardly. They are in full communion with the humanity at age 7 or 8.

This weekend, they enter full communion with the Church, although not yet. Until they receive Confirmation, they will not have completed the sacraments of Christian initiation which is why Archbishop Aquila has instituted the restoration of the 'right order' in our Archdiocese. The 'right order' is Baptism, Confirmation, Communion as is still practiced in the Eastern Church with infants and is the order for any older than 7 who have not been baptized and wish to enter the Church. But, for Catholics who were baptized as infants, the sacraments of Christian initiation became disordered and the symbolic movement into Christian identity distorted.

This weekend, we witness some of our parish youth approaching the altar for the first time to receive the body and blood of Christ and, in doing so, become for the first time what they receive: the body and blood of Christ. These children are asking the Risen Jesus to become a part of them in a very real way and they are asking the Risen Jesus to allow them to become a part of him in a very real way. They are also asking the Church to allow them to become full members of this body of Christ and we are welcoming them to the table of full membership in the body of Christ which is the Church.

This weekend, when we focus on Communion, table fellowship, full membership at the table, we are reminded that shared meals at the tables of our friends and families can be very contentious events and not the harmonious, joyous event we desire to share with one another.
