### **Notes from Fr. Tom**

Dear Loyola Parishioners & Visitors:

I am excited about our 10:00 am liturgy today! If what I expect to happen at it happens at it, then the choir will continue to be different although the membership is not different. Rather, our investment in monitors and stands and sound equipment I do not understand will continue to aid them in their ministry and our ability to hear them more fully, and their investment in rehearsals and attending music ministry workshops will pay off in their confidence and ability to exercise this ministry well.

Last Saturday night, we had an opportunity to celebrate all the ministry and team volunteers that sustain our parish life at Loyola. In 2014, we had about 40 people; last Saturday, we had about 80-85. It was a wonderful celebration.

At the 10:00 am Mass today, we have two baptisms. Yesterday, we had one. Our parish is alive and growing, as our city, neighborhood and parish attract new comers. Last Sunday, a couple who have yet to attend a liturgy with us came to the Open House for New Parishioners because they saw it posted on our website.

Our Religious Education program is gearing up for another year, and our youth have turned out along with their instructors to receive special acknowledgement and blessings. Our classes have increased significantly in size the last few years. This is good.

Finally, our Finance Council Chair is presenting our annual parish financial report. It is a positive report.

I am very pleased at where we are at on our ascent of the mountain. Today, I am stopping and taking in the view, resting a bit, determined this parish will continue the ascent to the mountain top Christ is calling us to as a parish. Christ has a view from the summit of our parish, of the way things are meant to be, that we have yet to realize is there or even begun to partially take in for ourselves. I truly believe this: God wants for us more than we can hope for or imagine.
