Unless shared with us by the Provincial or someone he delegates, Frs. Dirk, Joseph and myself will never see the report nor did we participate in the process or discussions other than myself to make brief introductions, express my gratitude for the participants' presence and leave. **Those who were unable to attend the summits may still offer input through November 15 via the parish website.** Fr. Bill Oulvey, the local Superior for the Loyola Jesuit Community, attended a few sessions and expressed his appreciation of Cindy as a facilitator and the Appreciative Inquiry approach to collecting the information.
