ON-SITE HANDICAPPED PARKING

Denver Public Works informed us there will be stronger enforcement of the rules associated with handicapped parking spaces. To park in a space designated as a handicapped parking space in our church lot, you must have a current placard issued in your name (or in a passenger's name only if the passenger is with you) hanging from the rearview mirror or a license plate that reflects this permit. Vehicles without a proper permit are subject to ticketing and towing.

Please note that the handicapped space access areas (white diagonal lines) have been repainted in our lot. Please also avoid parking in these areas. Thank you for helping us keep in compliance with the city.
